Description of event:	The event took place in the pine forests of the "Litorale di Ugento" natural park and saw the participation of stakeholders, children and lovers of trekking and nature. During the walk, our participants were able to sight numerous bird species in the protected area and were able to explore some issues related to the importance of habitats and the conservation value of animal and plant species, at risk of extinction, present in the natural park, with particular regard to the species of <i>Aythya nyroca</i> (Moretta Tabaccata), an endangered species. The activities then continued with an educational workshop on honey, bees and Mediterranean essences.

Description of event:	The event took place in the Monti Conomi wood, a place located in the heart of the "Litorale di Ugento" natural park and saw the participation of families, children and nature lovers. The program of activities included a walk through the woods, during which, with the support of expert environmental guides, our participants were able to do bird watching and wildlife sighting activities. Direct contact with nature has allowed users to reflect on the importance of habitats and the conservation value of endangered animal and plant species present in the natural park, with particular regard to the <i>Aythya nyroca</i> species (Moretta Tabaccata), an endangered species. The activities then continued with an educational and sensorial laboratory.

Description of event:	The event, which took place at the Monti Conomi forest, within the Ugento natural park, included some activities that allowed the participants to explore several issues related to the protection of biodiversity and the importance of the habitats present in the park, home of many plant and animal species, including the <i>Aythya nyroca</i> species (Moretta Tabaccata), today at risk of extinction. A first activity involved the realization of a treasure hunt, to discover the hidden animals present in the woods, and a second one concerned the presentation of the book "Le piante raccontano: storie, miti e tradizioni", whose aim was to raise awareness of respect for the environment around us and all its peculiarities.
