Description of event:	<p>The event took place in the Casa del Parco - Masseria Marina (in San Pietro in Bevagna, a fraction of Manduria) and saw the participation of volunteers, students and local stakeholders. The day was dedicated, for the first part, to the presentation of the Laspeh-Low Adriatic Species and Habitat project by the Management Body of the Regional Natural Reserves and in particular of the project aims and objectives to be pursued. The main objective of the event was to raise awareness, adults and children, on the importance of habitats, on the protection of biodiversity and on the conservation value of animal and plant species, at risk of extinction, present in the protected area, with particular regard to the species of the <i>Botaurus stellaris</i> (Linnaeus, 1758) (Bittern), through some activities that allowed the participants to come into direct contact with some animal and plant species of the Reserves. At the end of this, we proceeded with the planting of 200 Aleppo pine trees and essences typical of the Mediterranean scrub. The planting operations were followed by forestry workers from the Puglia Region and by Legambiente Manduria volunteers assisted by the students of the "Luigi Einaudi" Professional Institute for Agriculture.</p>

Venue:	Istituto Comprensivo "Don Bosco" Manduria
Description of event:	The event allowed the students of the secondary school of the I.C. "Don Bosco" Manduria, Fermi plexus, to spend a beautiful day at school, during which the children were able to deepen some environmental issues, including the importance of biodiversity and the protection of animal and plant species present in the Reserves. But not only: thanks to this project, the students became aware of the presence in the protected area of some endangered species, such as the "bittern" object of study among all the project partner parks, with activities in Italy, Albania and Montenegro. At the end of the day, an informative questionnaire was administered to the students. The interest and enthusiasm were such as to plan a visit to the field for the month of February, where the students dressed as expert "researchers" to carry out monitoring and censuses of the birdlife present in Salina Monaci.

Description of event:	The event allowed the students of the secondary school of the I.C. "Don Bosco" Manduria to spend a day near the Salina dei Monaci. The children, who have entered the role of little explorers, have learned to know and recognize some of the plants and wild birds present in Salina, guided by teachers and experts who operate within the Reserves. The boys were also able to deepen, directly on the field, some environmental issues including the importance of biodiversity and the protection of animal and plant species present in the Reserves and in particular they focused on the importance of these habitats for the protection Botaurus stellaris (Linnaeus, 1758) (Bittern), an endangered species. The activities, for the boys, ended after carrying out monitoring and censuses of the birdlife present in the Salina.
